3. Children under 13 years of age must *wear* a PFD while underway on a vessel under 21 feet in length. There are additional requirements for PFDs on children under 4 years of age. See pages 29-30 for more information.
4. Required on board permanently installed gasoline engines.
5. Required when boating on federally controlled waters (see page 33).
6. Certain items are not applicable to PWCs because they are not allowed to operate between sunset and sunrise.
7. Except all non-motorized vessels.
