**CRAB SEASON:** 4/1 – 12/15

**Peeler Crab:** 3 1/4 Inches – 4/1 – 7/14

**TIME RESTRICTIONS FOR TRIBUTARIES:**

April, October, November and December:  
1/2 hour after sunrise to sunset

May – September: 1/2 hour before sunrise to sunset

**TIME RESTRICTIONS FOR CHESAPEAKE BAY:**

April, October, November and December:  
1/2 hour after sunrise to 5:00 p.m.

May – September: 1/2 hour before sunrise to 5:00 p.m.

**CHESAPEAKE BAY CRAB BOAT LICENSE**

(Includes Recreational Crabbing)

**CHESAPEAKE BAY PLEASURE BOAT LICENSE**

(Includes indiv. Bay Sport and Recreational Crabbing)

A recreational licensee may not have more than:

- 1,200 feet of baited trotline per boat.
- thirty collapsible traps or crab net rings or a combination of thirty collapsible traps or crab net rings per boat.
- ten eel pots for catching your own bait.

**DAILY LIMIT:** With a recreational license, one bushel of hard crabs and two dozen peeler or soft crabs per person. No more than two bushels hard crabs or two dozen peeler or soft crabs per boat.
