Scotchman's Creek has been selected for use of Spectron Mitigation funds which are in excess of \$400,000. Cecil County has agreed not to rebuild the dam and may not rebuild the road, although local citizens are lobbying strongly for the road to be re-opened. Work is underway to spray the former lake with herbicide to kill the large stand of phrag. DNR, NOAA, and FWS are acting as the trustees for the mitigation money. Project partners include MDE who will likely fund wetland creation and Ducks Unlimited who will contribute herbicide, engineering and design experience and project dollars. The Trustees are seeking to purchase the property but need an entity to hold the title.
