

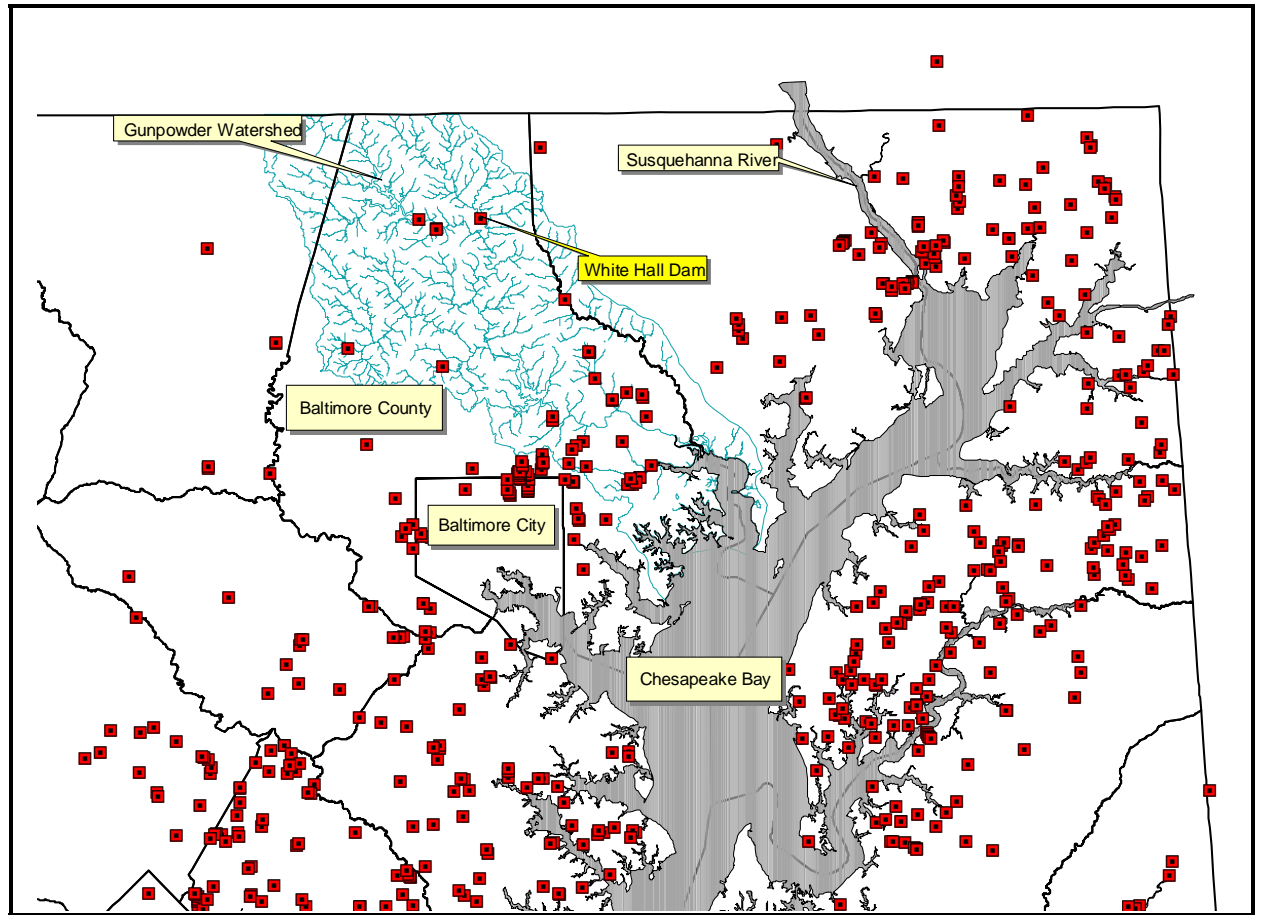

Little Falls contains a wild brown trout population above and below the dam. Thermal impacts are believed to be the biggest impact to brown trout populations below the dam. Thermal impacts may also be compromising cold-water releases from Prettyboy Dam in Big Falls. The Dam is 10 feet tall, 125 feet wide and approximately 4 feet thick. Dam owner, Bruce Fleming, is very eager to work with us to remove this dam.
